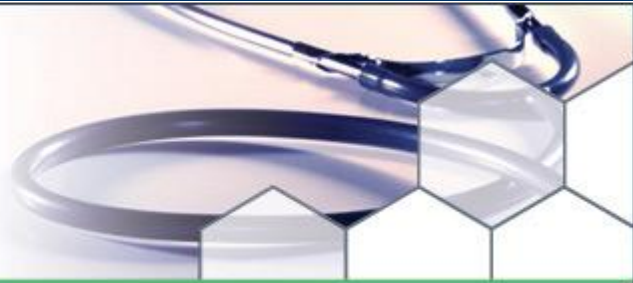

Action Required: Connecticut Physician Group Practice Reporting Deadline is December 31, 2015

Last year, Connecticut enacted P.A. 14-168, which requires hospitals, hospital systems, and physician group practices composed of 30 or more physicians to report to the attorney general and the Department of Public Health (DPH) certain information concerning group practices. In the case of hospitals and hospital systems, the reports must include information related to physician groups owned by or affiliated with the hospital or hospital system.

Reports must be filed annually. This year's filing deadline is **on or before December 31, 2015**. Filing instructions and the standardized reporting form are available on DPH's website and can be accessed [here](#). Reports must be filed by e-mailing them to GroupPracticeFilings@ct.gov.
