Norman H. Roos to lead national organization during 2019-2020 term

He has previously served in the roles of secretary, treasurer, and president-elect as well as Connecticut State Chair. Formed in 1974, ACMA's membership consists of nearly 500 lawyers in North America who are recognized leaders in the mortgage law industry. To be considered for membership, a qualified lawyer must be nominated by an ACMA Fellow and meet rigorous criteria.

Mr. Roos, concentrates his practice on transactional, regulatory, and technology matters relating to the financial services and real estate industries. He represents banks, insurance companies, diversified financial service companies, and other publicly and privately held entities on a broad range of matters involving consumer and commercial credit transactions, with a special focus on mortgage banking.
