Natalie Ramsey honored as a “Distinguished Leader” and Katherine Fix among the “Lawyers on the Fast Track”

PHILADELPHIA, PA (June 30, 2023) – Robinson+Cole Bankruptcy + Reorganizations Group co-chair [Natalie D. Ramsey](#) and member [Katherine M. Fix](#) were among the lawyers selected for recognition as part of *The Legal Intelligencer’s* 2023 Pennsylvania Legal Awards. The annual awards program took place on June 14, 2023, at the Loews Philadelphia Hotel, and honored “those lawyers who have left an indelible mark on the legal community in Pennsylvania and beyond through their unwavering dedication to the profession.” [Ramsey](#) and [Fix](#) were also highlighted in awardee features published in *The Legal Intelligencer*.

Ramsey, who is also the partner in charge of Robinson+Cole’s Philadelphia and Wilmington offices, was honored as a “Distinguished Leader,” a distinction that recognizes lawyers and legal professionals who achieved impressive results in the past year and demonstrated clear leadership skills that helped them achieve those results. In her role as co-chair of the firm’s Bankruptcy + Reorganizations practice, Ramsey is responsible for leading a team of highly skilled and experienced lawyers. In her tenure at the firm, the group has realized unprecedented and dynamic growth and profitability. Ramsey has taken part in some of the largest and most prominent Chapter 11 cases of the last 30 years. Among others, she served as special counsel to the Official E-side committee in the Energy Future Holdings Corp bankruptcy, co-counsel to the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors in the Mallinckrodt plc and affiliates, and counsel to the franchisee committee in Nutri-System. She is recognized as a leading authority in mass tort bankruptcy cases, having gotten her start in the field working as counsel on asbestos insulation manufacturer Celotex Corporation’s bankruptcy filing in the ‘80s and early ‘90s. Since then, Ramsey has represented victims and victim committees in multiple mass tort cases, including Combustion Engineering, Specialty Products (Bondex), Bestwall (a Georgia-Pacific affiliate), Imerys (a talc supplier to J&J), United Gilsonite Laboratories and Nutraquest. Ramsey is a Fellow of the American College of Bankruptcy, where she is the outgoing Third Circuit Regent. She is a current board member and former chairperson of the Consumer Assistance Bankruptcy Project, which provides pro bono bankruptcy assistance to indigent individuals in the Philadelphia region. She also previously served as president of the Eastern District of Pennsylvania Bankruptcy Conference. Recently, Ramsey was named a “Woman Restructuring

Leader” as part of Global M&A Network’s 2022 Turnaround Atlas Awards and named among the *ABF Journal’s* 2023 “Top Women in ABL.”

Fix was among the next generation of legal leaders named "Lawyers on the Fast Track." As counsel in Robinson+Cole’s Bankruptcy + Reorganizations Group, Fix concentrates her practice on bankruptcy and corporate restructuring matters. This encompasses representations of companies and creditors in Chapter 11 reorganizations, including special situations that require both transactional and litigation proficiency. Her experience includes both debtor and creditor representations of committees, corporate entities, and individuals with particular familiarity representing clients in contested matters and adversary proceedings. She has been selected as a Rising Star in the Pennsylvania *Super Lawyers* list from 2020 to 2023. In addition to her practice, Fix serves the Robinson+Cole and professional communities. She is a member of the firm’s Hiring Committee and is also dedicated to the mentorship of new lawyers.
